ST. ANN'S CONVENT, KANNANALLOR, KOLLAM, KERALA - 29th JUNE 1996.



It was a long cherished desire to branch out to have a convent of ours in the Diocese of Quilon was at last fulfilled. On 29th June 1996 St. Ann's Convent, Kannanalloor, Kollam, in the State of Kerela came into existence. It was also a desire cherished by the Bishop of Kollam, Most Rev. Joseph G Fernandez. He requested Mother Franceschina, the then Superior General and our dear Sr. Martin, Provincial Superior ever since Ayoor became part of Punaloor Diocese. Sister Jacintha mundadan was the first animator of the Community. His Lordship suggested that we take up a rented house near the plot of land that we had bought, so we could start our apostolate at Kannanalloor.

He offered an aided post of teacher in the Diocesan High School at Kollam. Sr.Rosaly.P. Thomas was appointed in the school and started to go to school from Ayoor, from 10th June 1996.

In June three Sisters were chosen and appointed for the new extension. Sr. Alphonsa.K, Sr. Catherine.V and Sr. Rosaly. P. Thomas. The Parish Priest of Kannanalloor found a small but a well-furnished house near our land for rent.

In 1998 the new Convent was blessed and inaugurated. Sr.Mercy Pulikal for the first Animator of the Community

In 1999 an additional 47 cents of land was Purchased and the L.K.G section was started with 37 students. At present the school has grown and now we have up to VII Std.



The sisters are involved in various apostolates like teaching Catechism in the Parish, visiting the houses and in the other pastoral works of the Parish.
